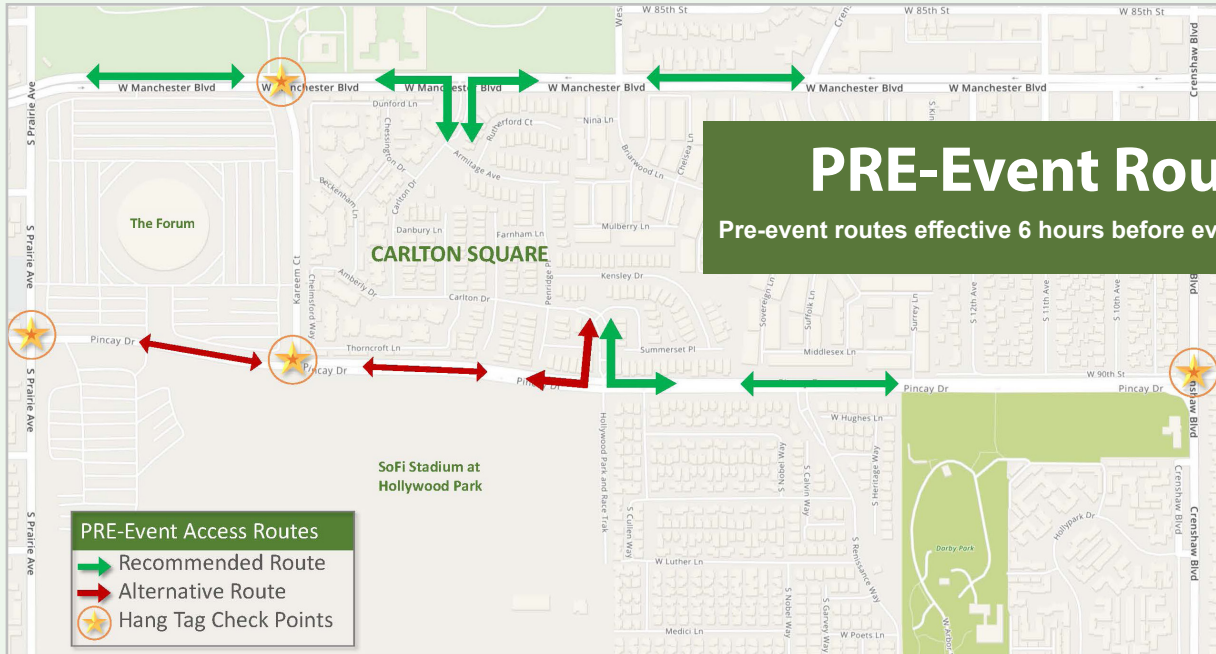


Carlton Square

Carlton Square



For residents of Carlton Square, an official hang tag from the City will be provided in order to facilitate entering and leaving the Carlton Square neighborhood before, during, and after scheduled events at The Forum and SoFi Stadium.

Contact Carlton Square Management office directly to receive your hang tag. Residents will be provided two hang tags per household. Additional hang tags can be provided as needed. Hang tags are not parking permits. Vehicles parked on parking-permitted streets without proper City parking permits will be ticketed regardless of hang tag.

An Inglewood Traffic Officer will be posted at check points (indicated by a gold star on the map). Traffic Officers will check for resident hang tags and direct residents into and out of the Carlton Square neighborhood.

Please have your hang tag visible during event days, and be prepared to stop and/or wait before entering Pincay or exiting Carlton Square.

Residents may experience delays during events but, whenever possible, use the recommended routes (green arrows).
